

SmartPTT Mobile Release Notes

Updated Features

In SmartPTT Mobile 5.2.0, the existing functionality has been updated and improved:

- Added text chats for messaging between SmartPTT Mobile users.
- Added the ability to activate the emergency mode to notify SmartPTT Mobile users and a dispatcher about an emergency and initiate emergency calls on priority conditions.
- Added the ability to edit the emergency settings.
- Added the ability to assign the Emergency button to the hardware Volume up and Volume down buttons of the device.

Text Chats

SmartPTT Mobile now supports text chats, providing the ability to exchange text messages between SmartPTT Mobile users. This function provides the ability to create a chat with an individual SmartPTT Mobile user and create chats with virtual groups.

The list of all text chats in SmartPTT Mobile is displayed after tapping **Chats** in the mobile application side menu.

Text chats with individual SmartPTT Mobile users are available from the **Chats** menu, the Contact List (from the specific contact's action menu) and from the contact's profile.

Emergency

SmartPTT Mobile now supports the emergency mode. This mode is used in case of emergency when the SmartPTT Mobile user needs to transmit in a higher priority mode.

The emergency mode provides the ability to send an alarm signal as well as initiate an emergency call with a higher priority than normal calls.

The emergency mode is activated in the SmartPTT Mobile application menu. For this, turn on the corresponding **Emergency** toggle in the application side menu.

SmartPTT Mobile users can always see which of the SmartPTT Mobile users has the emergency mode enabled.

In addition, SmartPTT Mobile users can now edit the emergency settings to select after which period of time to exit the emergency mode.

SmartPTT Mobile now provides the ability to assign an **Emergency** button to the hardware volume up and volume down buttons on the device. This feature makes sending an alarm signal similar to that of two-way radios.
